The gas leak at Union Carbide’s factory in Bhopal killed 8,000 people in one night.

People woke with eyes, nose and mouths burning. There was no warning. The factory’s alarm had been switched off. In panicky stampedes through narrow alleys, parents and children were wrenched apart, never to be re-united. People died with urine and faeces running down their legs, eyeballs white slits where the gases had bleached them. The gases stripped the linings from their lungs, and they drowned in their own fluids. Some convulsed and dropped dead in the streets. Next morning the city was full of twisted bodies.

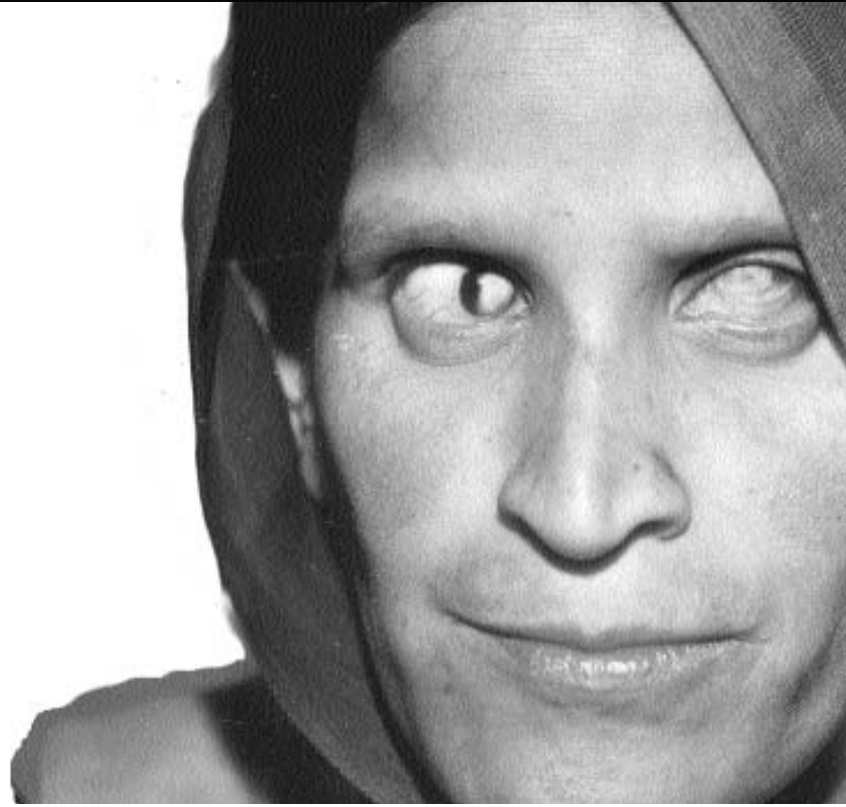

Nearly 18 years after “that night” about 120,000 survivors in Bhopal are still seriously ill.

They suffer from: breathlessness, blurred vision, exhaustion, aching bodies and heads, numbness, recurrent fevers and coughs, depression, anxiety attacks. Young adults develop cataracts. Teenage girls report menstrual chaos. There are monstrous births. The ‘compensation’ of \$500 over nearly 18 years would buy one cup of tea per day.

By contrast Alaskan sea-otters affected by the Exxon Valdez oil spill, were fed airlifted lobster at the cost of \$500 per day per otter. (Times of India)
